Abstract Guidelines

Only registered delegate/ faculty are allowed to submit abstract and present paper/ posters.

Instructions for Abstract Submission

The abstract must be original and should not be published or presented elsewhere earlier. The abstracts should be structured in English within 200 words (excluding title and references), with three keywords using Microsoft Times New Roman, 12 point, with double line spacing, with the title in bold.

It is mandatory that the Principal Author should be the presenting author and any award declared, will only be given to him/her.

- **Types of papers Accepted:** Original research papers.
- **Types of presentation:** Oral and Poster.
- **Review and notification to the authors:** All abstract will be reviewed and presenting author will be informed by e-mail of the acceptance or the rejections of their abstract.
- **Paper/Poster presentation:** Paper to be presented orally with the help of power point presentation with 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion, total 10 minutes. Size of poster should not be more than 4 feet in height and 3 feet in width (portrait).
- **Note:** Researchers are allowed to submit more than one abstract as presenting author.
- The final decision regarding the presentation rests with the organising committee. All abstract must be received by 31st July, 2023.
