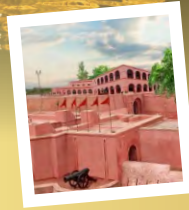
- 🔊 Oral presentation will be 8 to 10 minutes, followed by 3 to 5 minutes discussion.

## *About Amritsar*

Amritsar, the most sacred city of the Sikhs, is an important tourist attraction of Punjab. The word Amritsar means the pool of Nectar. The city of Amritsar is named after the sacred pool in the Golden Temple, one of the holiest Sikh shrines. Amritsar is situated only about 29 km from Wagah, on the Indian-Pakistan border.
